1. BOIL Advisory

Please, be aware that the city of Clarinda has announced a boil advisory for residents living in the area of 14th to 20th Street on Division, Willow, Clark, and Logan Streets until further notice.

This area includes the CCSD PK-6 building. School will be in session tomorrow the following precautions will be in place to ensure the health and safety of our students and staff:

- Our nutrition services will provide a grab and go breakfast.
- Our nutrition services will provide a sack lunch in place of hot lunch.
- All water (except toilets) will be turned off and inaccessible.
- Water bottles and water for visibly soiled hands/body parts and for medication dispensing will be available.
- Students and staff will utilize hand sanitizer for routine hand washing and cleaning purposes.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottle for use throughout the day.
- The ice machines will be turned off and sanitized prior to use.
- Coffee pots will be unavailable for use.
